



Standard Prunus Rootstocks

Lovell

Used in Sacramento Valley and in heavy soils where you would not use Nemaguard. Moderate to high vigor. High resistance to Bacterial Canker
Should be tested for: New pest and disease issues.

Areas to Avoid: Extreme wet soils (only moderately susceptible to wet soils). High salinity sites.

Availability: Now

Royalty: none

Mariana

Advantages: High resistance to Oak Root Fungus, but not immune

Successful Programs: Used only if you have Oak Root fungus. Avoid it anywhere you don't have oak root fungus

It gets graft union issues, mild etch

Parentage: Plum

Royalty: none

Hansen 536

Proven rock and roll Prunus rootstock. Hansen 536 is a Peach x Almond Hybrid and is propagated vegetatively.

Advantages: Best suited for Ten Lines June Beetle Grub

Successful Programs:

Areas to Avoid: Ring nematodes and Bacterial Canker sites

Should be tested for: Response to decreased Nitrogen applications.

Parentage: Peach X Almond

Origin: UC Davis

Availability: Now

Royalty: none

Nemaguard

Clonally propagated Nemaguard has shown to out perform seedling Nemaguard. Nemaguard has good vigor and production, most widely planted in Ca

Advantages: High Root-knot nematode resistance. Proven high yields.

Successful Programs: Sandy soils in the valley that may have nematodes.

Areas to Avoid: where Oak root fungus, Bacterial Canker and Phytophthora is has established. Not suitable for wet soil sites.

Should be tested for: New pest and disease issues.

Parentage: Peach

Availability: Now
